

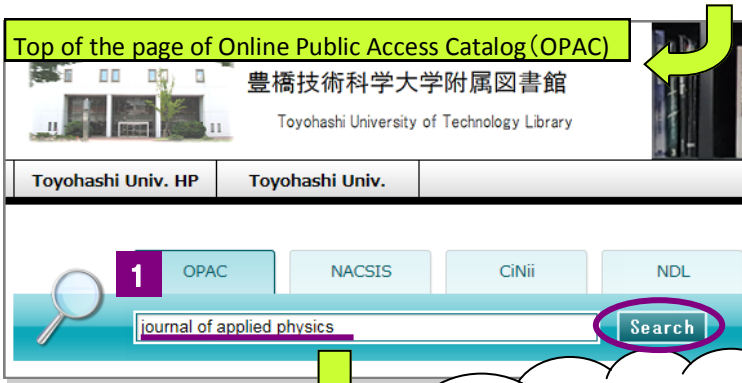
Finding magazines or E-Journals in University?

Let's try Online Public Access Catalog(OPAC)

You can search books and magazines that are available in **TUT Library** or laboratories through our website. No matter where you are this system is available for 24 hours.

In the case of magazines, you can search for the E-journals too!

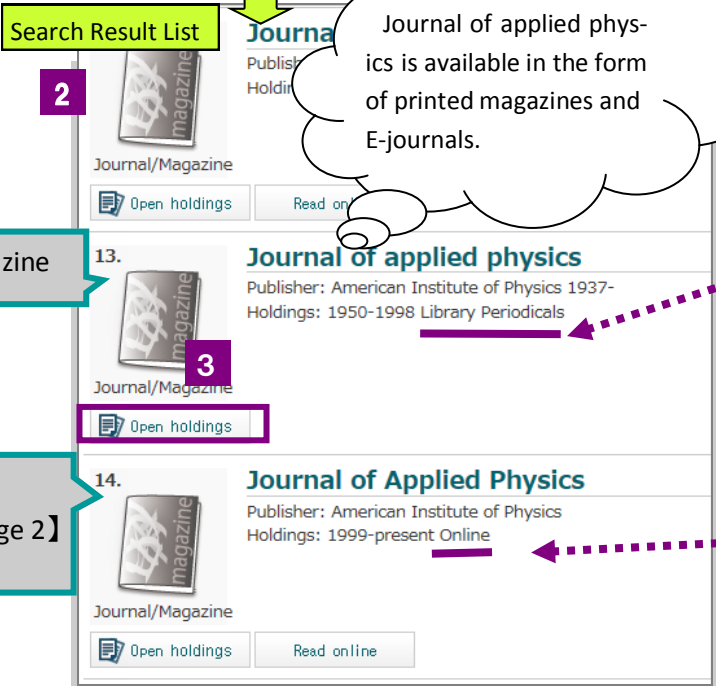
Go to TUT Library homepage http://www.lib.tut.ac.jp/index_e.html ,then click **“OPAC or other cross search databases (ex. CiNii, Amazon)”** from “Quick Search” column.



1 Type magazine's name, then click "Search"

SEARCH TIPS:

- **Keywords:** **journal of applied physics**
It will help you to get all the records that contain the words searched.
E.g.: Japanese journal of applied physics etc.
- **“Detail Search”**
Key in the **ISSN** (International Standard Serial Number) 8-digit code that used to identify books and magazines. Hyphen is unnecessary .E.g. : **ISSN: 00218979**

If printed journals

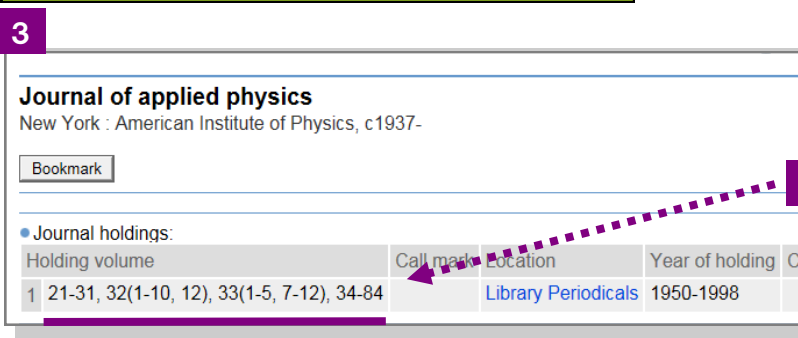
- **Holdings: Library** → you can find it in library
- **Holdings: Laboratory** → Professor has the book

If you want to borrow book from the laboratory, and separate library , you can ask our staffs at the counter.

Online : E-Journal is available!

Printed Journals: Foreign Journals from year 1988 and later , Japanese journals from year 1986 and later are at the 3rd floor, while journals before then are at the separate library. Journals are arranged in alphabetical order, and from the oldest to the latest. **You must follow the Copyright Law of Japan when you photocopy the library material. Fill in the “Document Copy” application form before you make a copy of the library material.**


Click title from the Search Result List



3 Click or the title of journal to know the details

E.g.: **21-31**→all issues from volume 21 to 31 are available.**32 (1-10,12)**→issue 11 is not available in volume 32

If E-journals are provided

4 Click  or the title of the journal, it will show you the detail of the journal.

5 Click  this monitor mark or "Link to Full Text"

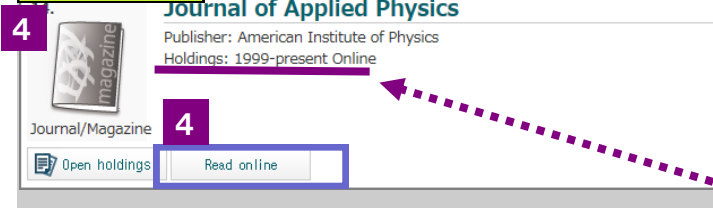
Both can link you to the E-Journal website.

This shows that the E-journal has Online access .

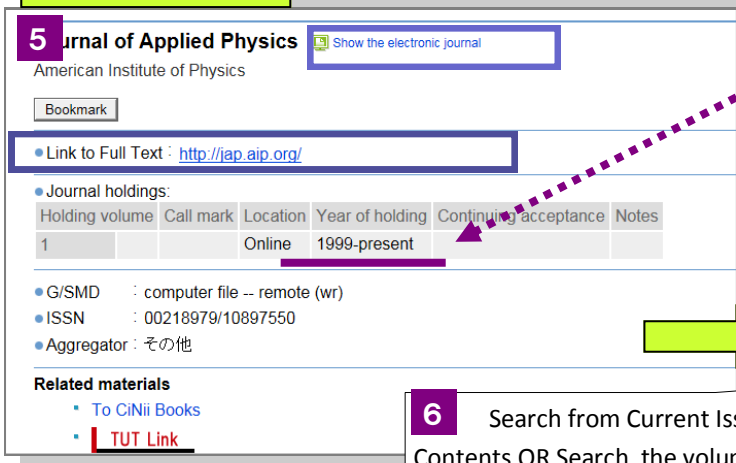
Holdings: 1999-present → you can get all the articles from 1999 to present in **FULL TEXT**.

(Other than the mentioned years, you can only enjoy the Abstract of the articles for free)

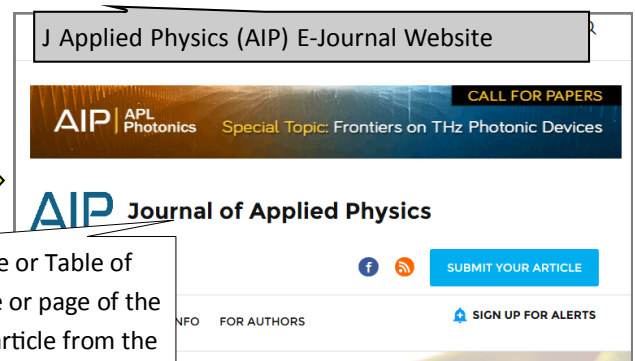

6 Search from Current Issue or Table of Contents OR Search the volume or page of the article or the author to get the article from the website. PDF file or HTML file will be provided.
